	<p>next certificate is the Magnet Certified School, McCollum is working on that. That will be submitted by the end of the school year. We had our Walk-Through with Dr. Trujillo. He walked around campus and he recognized the growth of Tully. The Makers Faire. The feedback from the staff positive. Our big focus on Special Education (Project Momentum- a state sponsored organization). Our SPED students are not progressing at the same rate as our mainstream students. Wilken wants to create a strong support from the mainstream classroom to the SPED classroom. Opening a line of better communication.</p> <p>We haven't had an update from the Bond Package. We will get an update soon. The first phase is safety and security; higher fencing. Override passed in November (5 years ago), more money for staff, half time PE teacher (for a school our size). More counseling money instead of Title 1. Possible Reading Interventionist. We don't have our Budget yet for next year.</p> <p>Negative: FTE (full-time employment) money might be affected. We don't have as many students as years before. Possibility of having only one 5th grade classroom next year. We will ask the district to look at our 100th day of school data, including the CCP/CCI rooms.</p> <p>Anticipating: Magnet coordinator, interventionist, CSP for next year.</p> <p>AZELLA is staring 1-29.</p>
